

Reducing food waste

Each year, the UK discards around 9.5 million tonnes of food waste, two-thirds of which is edible. Households are responsible for 70% of this waste, translating to a £14 billion annual loss. On average, each person wastes 70kg of food annually - that's around 140 meals. Commonly wasted items include bread, milk and fresh vegetables, often due to over-purchasing, improper storage or confusion over expiration dates. UK food waste contributes about 25 million tonnes of greenhouse gases every year, exacerbating climate change.*

How do we help?

Each summer, Transition Woodbridge members collect unwanted fruit from local gardens and orchards and redistribute it to community lunch clubs, the Salvation Army, Helping Hands, FIND and Stennetts Community Café. If you have surplus fruit or vegetables, are involved in a local scheme that could use this food, or would like to join our harvesting team, please get in touch with us.

- using up leftovers

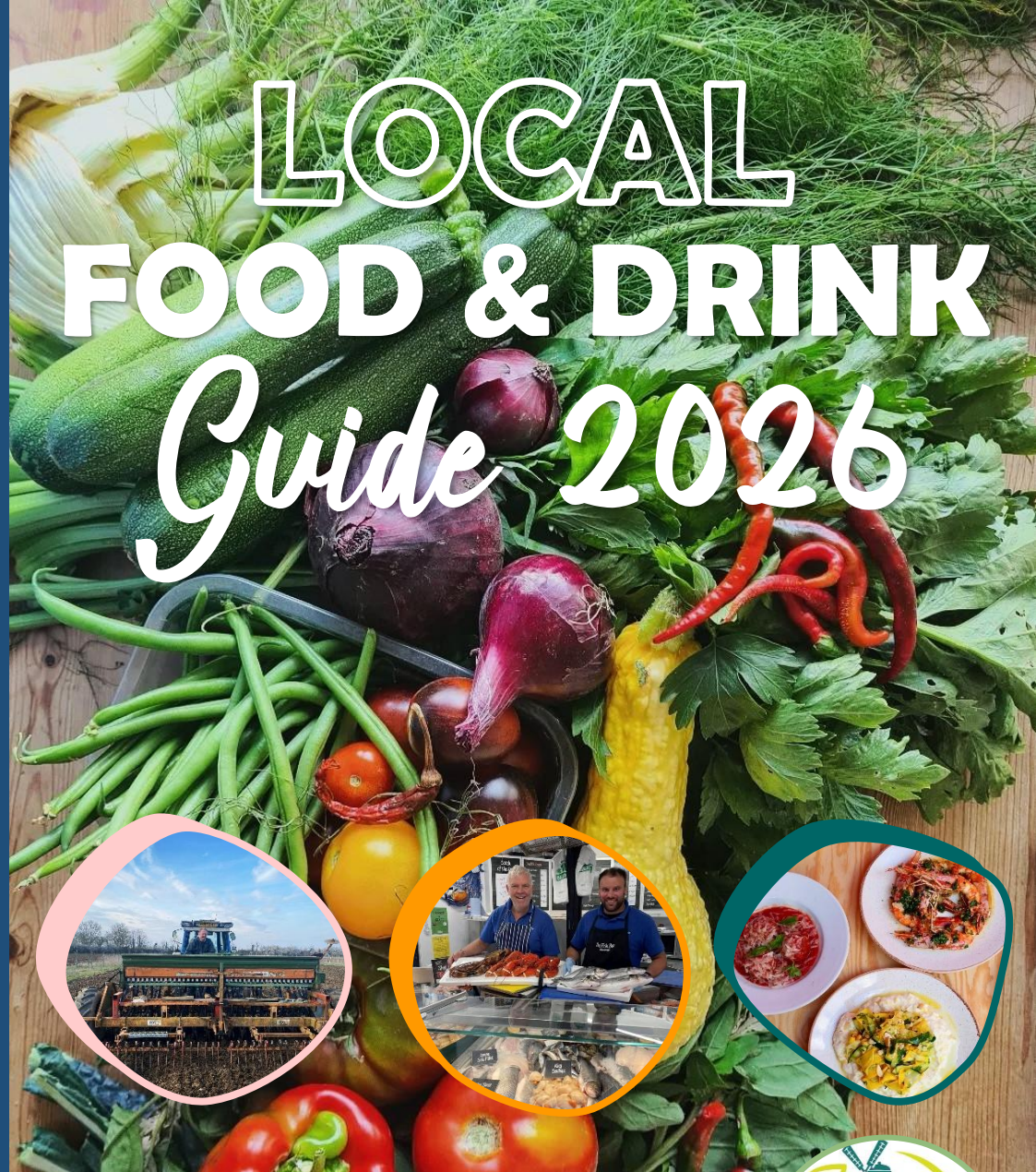

It is often fresher, healthier and more seasonal. It may even be bought direct from the producer at a farm shop or online and delivered to your door



Local shops and markets are good places to meet and chat, and are at the heart of our towns, helping to create their unique character

It typically requires less protective packaging and so generates less rubbish

Local farmers and growers care for our countryside and maintain high British standards of animal welfare

It travels a shorter distance from producer to consumer so less fuel is used, resulting in lower carbon emissions and pollution levels


